The Committee is elected at the AGM held in July.

Visitors are welcome to share the harvest from the table, and to join us for morning tea. Our public liability insurance covers all visitors to the garden.

Friends of the garden can sign up for email newsletters and garden updates. Please write your name and email address in the sign in book.

Children are welcome to join us in the garden with their parent or guardian. Please keep an eye out for each other; you remain responsible for looking after your children while at DEG.

♣ Under 15 year olds may only join DEG with an Adult family member. When they turn 15 they may become members of DEG in their own right.

- ♣ Contribute to the garden by attending gardening days and workshops. Encourage others
- ♣ Help to build a better environment and improve the Community in our area.

- ♣ All members over 15 years of age can vote and stand for election to the committee.
